Subject to COVID-19 restrictions, competitors must register **at least 1 hour** prior to their scheduled event. Further details regarding check-in and venue entry will be released closer to the Event.

Competitors are entitled to ONE chaperone pass which is included in your registration package.

Spectator Entry fees are as follows:

\$5.00 flat rate daily per adult

\$2 flat rate daily per child (12 years & under)

(Colour coded wrist bands will be provided and are to be worn daily during the event, otherwise a daily fee will be charged).

***Note spectator numbers will be subject to COVID-19 restrictions and may vary.**

OFFICIAL EVENT PHOTOGRAPHY / VIDEOGRAPHY

PHOTOGRAPHY

An official photographer will be taking photos at the event. Photos will be available for viewing and purchase.

For private photographers, please note that no flash photography is permitted in practice, warm-ups or events, as it may be dangerous to the skaters.

All private photographers are required to register at the Information / Registration desk on the day of the event.

VIDEOGRAPHY

Individuals using video cameras will be required to register at the Information / Registration desk on the day of the event.

No lights on cameras are permitted while videoing.

Videoing can only be undertaken in the clearly marked designated area.

VIDEOING OF PRACTICE SESSIONS AND OFFICIAL WARM-UPS IS **NOT PERMITTED.**

ACCREDITATION

Competitors

The competitor's accreditation lanyard **MUST** be visible at all times during the event, except during the warm up and performance. It will allow you entry into the ice rink for the duration of the four day event, breakfast service and access to the warm up area no more than 1 hour prior to the event with your coach. Without the visibility of this accreditation you will be charged an entry fee daily and not have access to the breakfast service or the warm up area.

Chaperones

The chaperone's accreditation lanyard **MUST** be visible at all times during the event. It will allow you entry into the ice rink for the specific day(s) that the relevant competitor is competing. Without the visibility of this accreditation you will be charged a daily entry fee.

Coaches

The APSA photo accreditation lanyard (this includes all interstate coaches) **MUST** be visible at all times during the event. It will allow you entry into the ice rink, breakfast service, lunch service and dinner service. New Zealand and international coaches will be issued a coach's accreditation badge upon their competitors first day of registration. Without the visibility of this accreditation you will be charged an entry fee daily and not have access to catering.
