<b>Membership Requirements</b>	<p>At close of entries, all Australian competitors must be a full financial member of their relevant State Association and an Affiliated Club (inclusive of ISA Insurance Registration either directly or via their State Association).</p> <p>The membership must be valid during the full competition period.</p> <p>All Aussie Skate™ entrants must also be registered with ISA Aussie Skate™.</p>

	Overseas entrants must be financial members of an ISU Member skating organisation and/or its affiliates, as required by their national organization; the membership must be valid during the full competition period.
<b>Insurance/Liability</b>	<p>All members of State Associations are covered under the ISA National Insurance Policy while participating in the event. This policy includes Sport Accident cover.</p> <p>ISA &amp; NSWISA assume no responsibility for other persons in connection with this event.</p> <p>ISA recommends that any person travelling to an interstate event consider personal travel insurance.</p>
<b>Eligibility to Compete</b>	<p>Skaters Preliminary and above must have passed the relevant ISA test level at the close of entries.</p> <p>Competitors in Aussie Skate™ divisions must compete at the highest test level passed by the competition closing date and cannot enter a level lower than that which they have previously competed. Aussie Skate refer: <a href="#">ISA Communication 101</a>.</p> <p>All competitors must meet the eligibility criteria outlined in the NSWISA Entry To State Artistic Championships Policy.</p>
<b>Practice Sessions</b>	There will be no official practices provided at this event.

<b>Conditions for Online Entry</b>	<p>Entries will be via the NSWISA online entry system.</p> <p>All interstate competitors must notify their relevant State Association of their entry submission <b>prior</b> to entering.</p> <p>All State Associations will be asked to confirm that entrants are full financial members in good standing, of both the State Association and an Affiliated Club (see details above).</p>
<b>Payment Process</b>	Online Payment at time of entry.

<b>Withdrawals</b>	<p>Refund only with a medical certificate provided <b><u>before the draw</u></b>.</p> <p><b>No refund permitted after the draw.</b></p> <p>A 20% administration fee to cover costs will be deducted from the refund.</p> <p>The music upload fee will not be refunded in case of withdrawal.</p>

<b>Other Music file notes</b>	<p>All competitors must have on hand at the event, a backup copy of their competition music on CD or USB Drive (or other device as permitted).</p> <p><b>Music (ISU Rule 343 Singles, Pairs &amp; Dance and ISU Rule 823 SYS): Please note paragraphs 1a), 1b), 1c), 2, 3, 4, re: Music Reproduction.</b></p> <p>Each program must be recorded on a separate file and labelled with competitor division, name and running time of the music.</p> <p>The electronic playlist will be deleted at the end of the event. All music remains the property of the skater and will not be shared or re-used.</p>
