Axel Achievement Award

The Axel Achievement Award is to recognise and acknowledge those Penrith Valley Figure Skating Club skaters who have achieved the Axel jump.

There are three award categories

- Single Axel
- Double Axel
- Triple Axel

To qualify for one of the award categories the skater must:

- Be a current and financial member of the Penrith Valley Figure Skating Club
- Execute the nominated Axel in a IJS Technical competition.
- The Axel must not be under-rotated.
- The landing of the Axel must be clean.
- The Axel cannot receive any deductions.
- The Axel must have been awarded 0 or + GOE by ALL relevant members of the Judging panel.
- The number of rotations in the Axel must correspond to the Award category.
- The Axel may be part of a combination jump if it meets the above criteria.
- The Judges Score for the skaters program must be able to be viewed on an open source website.

To receive an Award the skater or if under 16, a parent /guardian of the skater, must send an email to the Club President at pvfscpresident@gmail.com with the following information:

- The name of the Skater
- The date the nominated Axel was executed
- The competition the nominated Axel was executed
- A screenshot of the Judges score of the program the skater executed the nominated Axel. The screenshot must be of the whole of the skaters score sheet and all the score sheet details must be able to be clearly read.
- A link to the Ice Skating Association, ie NSWISA, ACTISA etc, website page which records the skaters Judges score in which the nominated Axel was executed.

A person on the PVFSC Committee who is not related to the skater will verify the details meet the criteria and are a true and correct, after which, it will be submitted to the PVFSC Executive Committee for approval. On approval the skater will be sent a congratulatory email, receive a certificate of attainment, an Axel achievement pin and their photo taken and posted on our social media and public platforms congratulating them in their achievement. If the skater or their parent/guardian does not want the skaters photo on the internet and/ or club notice board, it must be clearly stated in the nomination email. It will not influence the nomination approval process.
