Annual Award System



The Penrith Valley Figure Skating Club has annual awards in recognition of outstanding achievement in competitions throughout the year which are presented at the annual club presentation. Each winner receives an individual trophy, as well as having their name engraved on a perpetual shield which is kept at Penrith Ice Palace. These awards are as follows

- Presidents Senior Award – Senior, Junior, Advance Novice Technical Divisions
- Presidents Novice Award – Intermediate Ladies, Intermediate Novice, Basic Novice Technical Divisions
- Presidents Junior Award – Elementary, Preliminary Technical Divisions
- Presidents Adult Award – All Adult IJS Technical Divisions
- President Aussie Skate Award – All single Aussie Skate Technical Divisions
- PVFSC Artistic Award – All single Artistic Divisions

Skaters eligibility for an award is dependent on the division they compete in and a skater must receive points in three or more competitions in that award division to be eligible for consideration for the award. Points are not transferable from one award division to another.

Skaters earn points by competing in:

- Unlimited amount of NSWISA sanctioned competitions in NSW
- One competition outside of NSW

PLUS double points for

- Australian Figure Skating Championships (Nationals)
- One international competition (if selected by ISA to compete for Australia)
- Points are awarded for all NSW technical events including Aussie skate and one competition outside of NSW of the skater's choice. For the Senior, Adult and Novice Awards all points are doubled for the Australian Figure Skating Championships.

The points are awarded as follows:

- 10 points for placing first, providing there are more than 2 skaters in the division, otherwise they receive 8 points
- 8 points for placing second, providing there are more than 2 skaters in the division, otherwise they only receive the 5 participation points
- 7 points for placing third, providing there are more than 3 skaters in the division, otherwise they only receive the 5 participation points
- 5 participation points for entering a competition (if they do not place)
- In the case of a place tie at a competition, full points for the respective placing will be awarded to the PVFSC recipient/s.

The total of each skater's points will then be divided by the amount of competitions they participated in to receive their point score, the skater with the highest point score in the award division will receive the award.
