## Team Grant System



Penrith Valley Figure Skating Club (PVFSC) takes pride in assisting our members. As such we would like to offer our skating teams a Grant, available by application only, of up to \$500 per skating discipline, per calendar year.

A maximum of 1 grant for the Theatre-on-ice discipline and/or 1 grant for the Synchronised skating discipline can be applied for per calendar year.

These Grants are aimed to assist with the costs of competing, ice hire & costuming.

### In order to receive the above grant:

- All members of the team applying for the grant must be current PVFSC members in the year of the application for the grant.
- The team or it's representatives must volunteer a total of 12 hours of work per team per calendar year at PVFSC hosted competitions and/or events prior to applying for the grant.
- Volunteers under the age of 13 will require an adult accompanying them at all times to assist with the duties.
- Volunteer work from current PVFSC committee members is NOT eligible to count towards the 12 hours of volunteer work required on behalf of the team.
- Volunteers completing the 12 hours of work on behalf of the team will NOT be eligible for our \$15 discount pass which is currently awarded to our member volunteers.
- All Team Grant applications must be in writing and include a full list of current team members.

- Failure to comply with the above conditions will result in the Grant application being declined.
